VOTER REGISTRATION

VOTER REGISTRATION IS NOW REQUIRED BY FEDERAL AND STATE LAW.

In order to vote in the Special Primary Election, you must register to vote.

September 21st, 2011 at 5:00 p.m. is the deadline to register by mail. October 7th, 2011 at 5:00 p.m. is the last day to register in person at your Municipal Clerk's office. You may still register at the polls the day of the election, but it is highly recommended that you do so ahead of time. To register at the polls, bring your Drivers License or State issued ID if you have one, as well as some form of ID with your correct address on it such as a utility bill, phone bill, etc. Magazines and personal mail are not sufficient.

All other doors are locked after 5:00 for security reasons.
