<p>0%</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ 10-point Veteran preference in federal hiring (10 points added onto test score) ➤ No cost health care and prescription drugs for SC disabilities ➤ Travel allowance for scheduled appointments at VA medical facility or authorized facility ➤ Waiver of VA funding fee for VA home loan ➤ Burial and plot allowance ➤ Commissary and Exchange privileges
<p>10%-20% <i>In addition to above</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Eyeglasses provided at VA ➤ Eligibility VA Dental Insurance Program ➤ Vocational Rehab and Employment ➤ No cost healthcare
<p>30% <i>In addition to above</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Additional compensation for eligible dependents who are in a nursing home (may include A&A for eligible spouse) ➤ 10-point Veteran preference in federal hiring – Direct hire authority ➤ Additional allowance for dependent, full-time students aged 18-23 and parents ➤ Wisconsin GI Bill for dependent up to 8 semesters or 128 credits (UW Colleges or WTC) ➤ Wisconsin Veteran Grant for Private Non-Profit Schools for higher education Serves dependents up to 128 credits, 8 semesters, or 8 sessions
<p>40% <i>In addition to above</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Automobile grant and/or special adaptive equipment for automobile <i>Eligibility requirement: permanent loss or loss of use of one or both legs or hands and/or permanent impaired vision of BOTH eyes</i>
<p>50% <i>In addition to above</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Concurrent receipt of military retired pay ➤ VA medical outpatient treatment for any condition except dental. ➤ Pre-authorized hospital care and medical service in non-VA facilities ➤ Concurrent retirement and disability pay (DoD program) ➤ Disabled Veterans Recreation Card (\$7)
<p>60% <i>In addition to above</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Possible increased compensation, paid at the 100% rate, based on Individual Unemployability (IU). May receive the following if granted permanent IU: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Dependents Educational Assistance ○ Special Restorative Training ○ CHAMPVA ○ Dental Care
<p>70%-90% <i>In addition to above</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Eligibility for Nursing Home care through VA or VA contracted nursing home ➤ Waivers for vehicle admission and trail pass fees for State of Wisconsin Parks and Trails ➤ Resident Disables Veterans reduced-fee fishing license (\$3)
<p>100% <i>In addition to above</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ No cost dental care ➤ Uniformed Services ID card ➤ National Service Life Insurance total disability income provisions ➤ CHAMPVA (if not eligible for Tricare) ➤ Survivors and dependents education assistance (Title 38 USC Chapter 35) ➤ Military ID ➤ Special Adapted Housing ➤ Special Home Adaptation Grant ➤ Some VA life insurance policy holders may have their premiums waived ➤ Veterans with 100% P&T VA disability compensation rating may be eligible for Social Security Disability benefits ➤ Wisconsin Veterans Property Tax Credit
